IMPORTANT INFORMATION / TIPS

Please do not send any Frozen consignments via flight transfers within China. Please arrange consignments arrival Hong Kong airport within the deadline stated. Otherwise, additional cold storage fee will be incurred!

DO NOT SEND ANY EXHIBITS BY COURIER

Exhibitors are advised not to send their exhibits through courier services such as FDEDEX or DHL, as this may cause a delay in delivery of their exhibits to your booth. The courier cannot provide customs clearance services for the exhibition. As such, this may not only cause a delay to retrieve exhibits from airport customs, but might also result in more costly customs formalities.

DO NOT HANDCARRY IN ANY SEAFOOD

Exhibitors who arrive in China through an airport of entry other than Qingdao should not hand-carry any exhibits. Should exhibits be detained by airport customs, retrieving the exhibits in time for the show may be

difficult. The Hygiene Department in Qingdao will not arrange any inspection of all the hand-carried seafood. We do not recommend exhibitors hand carry any items of seafood to Qingdao for exhibition.

DO NOT GIVE AWAY ANY SEAFOOD DURING THE EXHIBITION PERIOD

In accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Quarantine, China, all seafood used for exhibitions purposes only, cannot be transferred or cast away. This regulation is used to prevent infectious or parasitic diseases from spreading into the country.

PACKING OF FROZEN SEAFOOD

Exhibitors who exhibit frozen/chilled seafood must pack seafood into foam box not into cardboard box. Ensure there is enough gel ice in the foam boxes instead of dry ice, as airlines will classify dry ice as dangerous cargo.

CERTIFICATE

All the Original Hygiene Certificate, Certificate of Origin (C.O.O.), Fumigation Certificate must have Government Stamp. Without the stamp the China Customs will not accept the goods and they must be returned to the original country.
